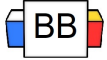

What is a question mark?

- A question mark is an end punctuation mark.
- The main purpose of a question mark is to indicate that a sentence is a question.

How is it used?

- Interrogative Sentence
- Direct Question
- Etc.

What's an interrogative sentence?

An interrogative sentence asks a question.

- This sentence often begins with who, what, where, when, why, how, or do.
- It ends with a question mark.

Example: Did you ever watch a dingo devour its paw?

Direct Question




- A direct question is a question that can be answered.
- It is not a statement: it is an interrogative sentence.
- It always ends in a question mark.

Example: Why can't I ever detect liars?

Example: How am I supposed to live without carne asada burritos?
