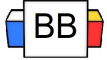

What is a list?

- A simple series of words or numerals (such as the names of persons or objects)

Example: I love ice cream, llamas, and oblivion.

- Use commas to separate the items in a series.
- A series is a list of three or more items in a sentence.
- Place a comma before the conjunction ("and," "but," or "or").




Example: You may be required to bring worms, unicorns, dragons, and puppies.

Example: I need to purchase ramen, water, and organs.

Example: Nathan, Marjani, and Joey went to the music festival.
