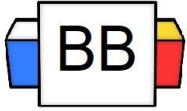

Predicate

The predicate is the verb that explains what the subject is doing.

Example: Dracula combusted into flames after drinking SunnyD.

Example: Predator stalked Arnold Schwarzenegger through the jungle.

Simple Predicate

The simple predicate is always a verb (word or words that express an action or state of being). It is usually one word.

Example: Mickey Mouse engaged in a gang fight.

Complete Predicate

A complete predicate includes not only the verb or verb phrase but also all the words that give more information about it.

Example: Dracula combusted into flames after drinking Sunny-D.

Example: Predator stalked Arnold Schwarzenegger through the jungle.

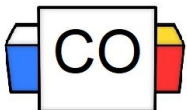
