	Compound Sentence
	A compound sentence joins 2 independent clauses together to form one sentence.  Compound sentences can be made in a variety of ways.
	Compound Sentence Structure 1: One of the most common ways of combining 2 independent clauses together is by using a comma and a coordinating conjunction (FANBOYS).
	F.A.N.B.O.Y.S. is an acronym that is used to remember the 7 basic coordinating conjunctions.

### Compound Sentence Formula 1:

1 independent clause + , + FANBOYS + 1 independent clause (1 IDC) + (,) + (FANBOYS) + (1 IDC)

### Example Breakdown:

**Independent clause 1**: My life is a mess.

**Independent clause 2**: No one can control me.

Combined to form a compound sentence.

My life is a mess, and no one can control me.
(1 IDC) + (,) +(FANBOYS) + (1 IDC)

### Important Note:

You need to place the comma BEFORE the coordinating conjunction when joining the two independent clauses.

Incorrect example: My life is out of control and, I really need to handle it.

Correct example: My life is out of control, and I really need to handle it.

# Important Note 2:

It would be best to have both a comma and a FANBOYS to make a compound sentence. Either or on its own is not strong enough to bring the 2 independent clauses together.

### Example:

The witch in Hansel and Gretel didn't want to go hungry, so she devoured children instead.
