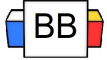

What is a period?

- A period (in America) is a full stop (.).
- It is a punctuation mark at the end of a sentence.
- It shows that the sentence has finished.
- To be a sentence, it must have at least one complete clause with a verb and a subject.

How can periods be used?

- To end a sentence (at least one independent clause)
- To end a declarative or imperative sentence
- To end an indirect question
- To abbreviate titles, words, etc.

Usage 1: Declarative Sentence

- A declarative sentence expresses an opinion or makes a statement. It makes a declaration.
- It ends in a period.

Rule: Put the period at the end of a declarative sentence.

Example: Sasquatch is a dedicated vegetarian.

Example: My skydiving experience was terrifying.

Example: The baby roamed through the house at night.

Example: Derek's cats staged a mutiny against him.

Example: Zeus can throw lightning bolts.

Usage 2: Indirect Questions

- An indirect question is a question embedded within a statement or another question.
- A sentence featuring an indirect question might not end in a question mark, depending on the type of sentence it joins. (It usually ends in a period.)

Example: I was wondering if Godzilla enjoys green tea.

Example: I would like to know why he moved to this kingdom.

Example: I wonder if Zeus uses lightning or thunder.

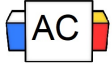
