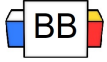

What is an exclamation point?

An exclamation point (!) is used primarily after an interjection or exclamatory sentence to indicate a strong feeling(s).

How can an exclamation point be used?

- To end an exclamatory or imperative sentence
- To add emphasis to interjections and sentence fragments

What is an interjection, and what do they do?

Answer:

Put after an interjection to add emphasis/stronger emotion.

Mr. GG: Whoa!

Mr. AA: Ughhh!

Mr. II: Interesting!

Dino: Whoops!

Exclamatory Sentences

An exclamatory sentence expresses strong or forceful emotion, such as anger, surprise, or joy. Any exclamatory sentence can be properly followed by an exclamation point to add emphasis.

Example: I won the raffle!

Example: Her cat is out of control!



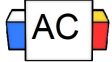

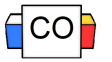
